WHAT: The Arc is partnering with Boise Rescue Mission, and asking the community to donate non-perishable items along with their usual Arc donations of clothing and household items. The Arc will collect the food for Boise Rescue Mission in an effort to keep up with the growing number of meals served each day to homeless and hungry guests.

WHEN: August 31-September 7, 2009

WHY: The Arc and Boise Rescue Mission are working together in an effort to better the local community.

The first week in September, donate canned good items along with the usual clothing and household items to The Arc! The Arc trucks will be stocked with Boise Rescue Mission food barrels and all non-perishable items will be donated to the Mission's shelters.

For over fifty years, Boise Rescue Mission has provided food, shelter, clothing, counseling, education and job search assistance for men, women and children in need. In 2008, the Mission provided 299,220 meals, 86,658 overnight stays and transitioned 390 men and women from homelessness into independent living. The Mission is the largest provider of homeless services in the State of Idaho.

The Arc has been providing services in the Treasure Valley since 1956 and is committed to securing for all people with intellectual and developmental disabilities, in partnership with their families, the opportunity to choose and realize their goals of where and how they learn, live, work and play.
